DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Arrive in Winnipeg and check into your hotel conveniently located at the airport; Welcome reception hosted by a Frontiers North Interpretive Guide; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 2: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Early morning flight to Churchill; Churchill and area tour; Parks Canada Visitor Centre interpretive program; Polar Bears International House visit; Cultural Presentation from a local Indigenous person; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 3 & 4: TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Spend a full day out in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area observing polar bears and other subarctic wildlife on a Tundra Buggy®; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 5: DOG SLEDDING & MORE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Dog Sledding; Explore town with your group; Itsanitaq Museum interpretive program; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 6: DEPART WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure.



Included Activities

CHURCHILL AND AREA TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility, and Inukshuk.

CULTURAL PRESENTATION: An evening presentation from a local Indigenous Churchill resident about the culture, history, wildlife, and/or lifestyle of Churchill.

DOG SLEDDING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding, and enjoy an exhilarating dog sled ride.

ITSANITAQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre-Dorset, Dorset, Thule, and modern Inuit times.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL HOUSE: Hear from a Polar Bear International representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Search for wild polar bears on a full day Tundra Buggy® adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area.
