DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Arrive in Winnipeg and check into their hotel; Welcome reception hosted by a Frontiers North Interpretive Guide; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 2: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Early morning flight to Churchill; Churchill and area photo tour; Cultural Presentation from a local Indigenous person; Afternoon Dog Sledding and Interpretive Program; Parks Canada Visitor Centre; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 3: TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE (MEALS: B, L, D)

First full day Tundra Buggy® Adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; transfer to the Tundra Buggy Lodge; Overnight Tundra Buggy Lodge.

DAY 4 & 5: TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Two full days out in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area photographing polar bears and other subarctic wildlife on a Tundra Buggy® and returning back to the Tundra Buggy Lodge in the evenings; Overnight Tundra Buggy Lodge.

DAY 6: FINAL TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Full day Tundra Buggy® excursion in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area photographing wildlife; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Guests check into their Winnipeg hotel; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 7: DEPART WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure.
