DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG (MEALS: D)

Arrive in Winnipeg and check into their hotel; Welcome reception hosted by a Frontiers North Photo Specialist Guide; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 2: YOUR CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Early morning flight to Churchill; Introductory Northern Lights Photo Workshop; Explore the town on a Churchill and area photo tour; Evening visit to Thanadelthur Lounge for northern lights viewing and Photo Workshop; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 3: DOG SLEDDING AND DAN'S DINER CULINARY EXPERIENCE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Dog Sledding and Interpretive Program; Cultural Presentation with a local person; Dan's Diner Culinary Experience and northern lights viewing; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 4: SNOWSHOEING AND FOREST EXCURSION (MEALS: B, L, D)

Interpretive Snowshoe Trek and optional Fat Biking; Tundra Buggy® Adventure; Evening Forest Excursion to photograph the aurora; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 5: POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL AND NORTHERN LIGHTS VIEWING (MEALS: B, L, D)

Polar Bears International House; Parks Canada Visitor Centre; Itsanitsaq Museum; Cultural Presentation with a local person; Evening visit to a log cabin and teepee for northern lights viewing; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 6: LAST DAY IN CHURCHILL (MEALS: B, L, D)

Churchill Northern Studies Centre and Rocket Range Tour; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Check into and overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 7: DEPART WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure.



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Included Activities

CHURCHILL AND AREA PHOTO TOUR: Tour Churchill's most photogenic sites and discover creative photo opportunities with your Photo Specialist Guide.

CULINARY EXPERIENCE: Travel by Tundra Buggy® across the frozen river to Dan's Diner, an exclusive pop-up restaurant in the wilderness.

CULTURAL PRESENTATION (X2): An evening presentation from a local Indigenous Churchill resident about the culture, history, wildlife, and/or lifestyle of Churchill.

DOG SLEDDING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding, and enjoy an exhilarating dog sled ride.

FOREST EXCURSION: Escape the lights of town for aurora borealis-viewing opportunities from an extraordinary locale in the boreal forest.

ITSANITSAQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre-Dorset, Dorset, Thule, and modern Inuit times.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

PHOTO WORKSHOP: Partake in an introductory photo workshop led by one of our Photo Specialist Guides.

POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL HOUSE: Hear from a Polar Bear International representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

ROCKET RANGE: A guided tour of the Churchill Rocket Range National Historic Site - built in 1954 - and learn about its ties to the Canadian Space Agency and NASA. As the first rocket range in Canada, this site was home to extensive suborbital research, including fascinating experiments on the northern lights.

SNOWSHOE TREK: Enjoy the solace of an interpretive snowshoeing adventure through the boreal forest.

THANADELTHUR LOUNGE: Travel by Tundra Buggy® across the river to our warm and secluded lounge for peak aurora-viewing opportunities.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Reach remote locales in the wilderness across the frozen Churchill River on board the official Tundra Buggy.
