Experience the spectacular wildlife of Manitoba with an adventure from the expansive forests and grasslands of Riding Mountain National Park, to the colourful tundra of Churchill. Our one-of-a-kind Big Five Safari is a salute to the incredible array of megafauna that populate the forests, prairies, tundra and waters of this beautiful province.

Your journey begins in Winnipeg, the geographic centre of North America. Travel overland to Riding Mountain National Park where the boreal forest, meadows and lakes, lofty heights and deep gorges of the Manitoba Escarpment are home to moose, black bears, a captive bison herd and more. Enjoy daily wildlife drives to photograph the amazing wildlife and landscapes of the area. Next, fly north to Churchill, where the boreal forest gives way to the rugged tundra and northern waterways. Set out by boat and Zodiac amongst inquisitive beluga whales and explore the Churchill Wildlife Management Area in search of the majestic polar bear.

DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG (MEALS: D)

Guests will arrive into Winnipeg and check into their hotel; Welcome reception hosted by a Frontiers North Interpretive Guide; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 2: START YOUR JOURNEY AT RIDING MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK (MEALS: B, L, D)

Morning bus transfer to Riding Mountain National Park; Stop at Farmery Estate Brewery; Evening wildlife drive; Overnight at Lakehouse hotel.

DAY 3: WILDLIFE VIEWING AND INTERPRETIVE HIKE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Morning wildlife drive; Parks Canada Interpretive Walk; Interpretive Hike; Outdoor dining experience; Lake Audy bison enclosure and wildlife drive; Overnight at Lakehouse hotel.

DAY 4: LAST WILDLIFE SAFARI IN RIDING MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK (MEALS: B, L, D)

Morning wildlife drive; Turtle Island Cultural Experience; Drive to Winnipeg; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 5: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Morning flight to Churchill; Churchill and area tour; Parks Canada Cape Merry Tour; Cultural Presentation from a local person; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 6: BELUGA WHALES AND DOG CARTING (MEALS: B, L, D)

Beluga whale viewing on a Zodiac in the Churchill River Estuary; Itsanitag Museum; Dog Carting and Interpretive Program; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 7: PRINCE OF WALES FORT AND BELUGA WHALES (MEALS: B, L, D)

Parks Canada Visitor Centre; Beluga whale viewing and boat tour of the Churchill River; Interpretive walking tour of Prince of Wales Fort; Polar Bears International House; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 8: TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Tundra Buggy® adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 9: DEPART WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure.



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Included Activities

BELUGA AND FORT TOUR: Discover hundreds of beluga whales by boat and enjoy a guided tour of Prince of Wales Fort National Historic Site.

BELUGA BOAT TOUR: Get a behind-the-scenes tour of the Beluga Boat, a vessel documenting the belugas in the Churchill River.

BELUGA ZODIAC: A guided excursion into the Churchill River beluga whale estuary in an inflatable Zodiac boat.

BISON ENCLOSURE: Visit Lake Audy's bison enclosure and learn about the history and importance of the bison in North America.

BREWERY TOUR: Visit Farmery Estate Brewery in Neepawa for a brewery tour and lunch at their delicious on-site food truck.

CHURCHILL AND AREA TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility, and Inukshuk.

CULTURAL PRESENTATION X2: An evening presentation from a local Indigenous Churchill resident about the culture, history, wildlife, and/or lifestyle of Churchill.

DOG CARTING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding, and enjoy an exhilarating dog cart ride.

INTERPRETIVE HIKE: Hike through the scenic wetlands of RMNP's Ominik Marsh.

INTERPRETIVE WALKING TOUR: Take in the historic townscape of Wasagamung, located in the heart of RMNP, on an interpretive walking tour.

ITSANITAG MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre-Dorset, Dorset, Thule, and modern Inuit times.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL HOUSE: Hear from a Polar Bear International representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Search for wild polar bears on a full day Tundra Buggy® adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area.

WILDLIFE DRIVE: Explore Riding Mountain National Park on safaris in search of black bears, moose, and other incredible wildlife.
