You might even have the opportunity to see the first of the summer polar bears as they begin to return from the sea ice throughout the summer months.

DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG (MEALS: D)

Guests will arrive into Winnipeg and check into their hotel; Welcome reception hosted by a Frontiers North Adventures Interpretive Guide; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 2: THE TRAIN VOYAGE BEGINS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Board VIA Rail train early afternoon; Begin first leg of journey to Churchill; Overnight on train.

DAY 3: DAY ON THE TRAIN (MEALS: B, L, D)

Continue on journey from Winnipeg to Churchill; Overnight on train.

DAY 4: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Morning arrival into Churchill; Churchill and area tour; Polar Bears International House; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 5: BELUGA WHALE ZODIAC TOUR (MEALS: B, L, D)

Zodiac boat ride on the Churchill River; Itsanitaq Museum; Parks Canada Visitor Centre; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 6: BELUGA KAYAKING (MEALS: B, L, D)

Beluga Kayaking; Cultural Presentation from a local Indigenous person; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 7: BELUGA WHALES, DOG CARTING, AND PRINCE OF WALES FORT (MEALS: B, L, D)

Dog Carting and Interpretive Program; Beluga whale viewing and boat tour of the Churchill River; Interpretive walking tour of Prince of Wales Fort; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 8: TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Tundra Buggy® adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Guests check into their Winnipeg Hotel.

DAY 9: DEPART WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure.



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Included Activities

BELUGA AND FORT TOUR: Discover hundreds of beluga whales by boat and enjoy a guided tour of Prince of Wales Fort National Historic Site.

BELUGA KAYAKING: Get closer to the beluga whales on a kayaking excursion in the Churchill River.

BELUGA ZODIAC: A guided excursion into the Churchill River beluga whale estuary in an inflatable Zodiac boat.

CHURCHILL AND AREA TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility, and Inukshuk.

CULTURAL PRESENTATION: An evening presentation from a local Indigenous Churchill resident about the culture, history, wildlife, and/or lifestyle of Churchill.

DOG CARTING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding, and enjoy an exhilarating dog cart ride.

ITSANITAQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre-Dorset, Dorset, Thule, and modern Inuit times.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL HOUSE: Hear from a Polar Bear International representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Search for wild polar bears on a full day Tundra Buggy® adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area.
