DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Arrive in Winnipeg and check into your hotel conveniently located at the airport; Welcome reception hosted by a Frontiers North Interpretive Guide; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 2: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Early morning flight to Churchill; Churchill and area tour; Itsanitaq Museum; Polar Bears International House welcome reception; Cultural Presentation from a local Indigenous person; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 3: DOG SLEDDING AND TUNDRA BUGGY LODGE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Dog Sledding and Interpretive Program; Polar Bears International House; Afternoon Tundra Buggy® transfer to the Tundra Buggy Lodge; Overnight at Tundra Buggy Lodge.

DAY 4 & 5: TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE & POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL (MEALS: B, L, D)

Full day Tundra Buggy® adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Presentation from Polar Bears International Scientist; Overnight at Tundra Buggy Lodge.

DAY 6: FINAL TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Full day Tundra Buggy® adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Guests check into their Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 7: DEPART WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Included Activities

CHURCHILL AND AREA TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility, and Inukshuk.

CULTURAL PRESENTATION: An evening presentation from a local Indigenous Churchill resident about the culture, history, wildlife, and/or lifestyle of Churchill.

DOG SLEDDING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding, and enjoy an exhilarating dog sled ride.

ITSANITAQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre-Dorset, Dorset, Thule, and modern Inuit times.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Search for wild polar bears on a full day Tundra Buggy® adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area.
