DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG (MEALS: D)

Arrive in Winnipeg and check into hotel; Welcome reception hosted by a Frontiers North Photo Specialist Guide; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 2: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Early morning flight to Churchill; Churchill and area photography tour; Photography Workshop Cultural Presentation from a local Indigenous person; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 3: BELUGA WHALES, COASTAL HIKE, AND PRINCE OF WALES FORT (MEALS: B, L, D)

Rocket Range Photography and Tour; Coastal Hike; Beluga whale viewing and boat tour of the Churchill River; Interpretive walking tour of Prince of Wales Fort; Sunset Photography Drive; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 4: BELUGA WHALES AND NIGHT PHOTOGRAPHY (MEALS: B, L, D)

Beluga whale Zodiac tour on the Churchill River; Polar Bears International House; Astrophotography Workshop; Photography Tour: Nighttime Town and Area; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 5: DOG CARTING, BELUGA WHALES, AND MAYBE POLAR BEARS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Dog Carting and Interpretive Program; Itsanitatq Museum; Beluga whale zodiac and possible coastal polar bear viewing; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 6: LAST DAY IN CHURCHILL (MEALS: B, L, D)

Tundra Buggy® Adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 7: DEPART WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure.



Included Activities

BELUGA AND FORT TOUR: Discover hundreds of beluga whales by boat and enjoy a guided tour of Prince of Wales Fort National Historic Site.

BELUGA ZODIAC: A guided excursion into the Churchill River beluga whale estuary in an inflatable Zodiac boat.

CHURCHILL AND AREA PHOTO TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility, and Inukshuk.

COASTAL HIKE: Embark on a scenic morning coastal hike to the Churchill Northern Studies Centre.

CULTURAL PRESENTATION: An evening presentation from a local Indigenous Churchill resident about the culture, history, wildlife, and/or lifestyle of Churchill.

DOG CARTING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding, and enjoy an exhilarating dog cart ride.

ITSANITATQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre-Dorset, Dorset, Thule, and modern Inuit times.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

PHOTO TOUR: Tour Churchill's most photogenic sites and discover creative photo opportunities with your Photo Specialist guide.

PHOTO WORKSHOP: Partake in an introductory photo workshop led by one of our Photo Specialist Guides.

POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL HOUSE: Hear from a Polar Bear International representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

ROCKET RANGE: A guided tour of the Churchill Rocket Range National Historic Site - built in 1954 - and learn about its ties to the Canadian Space Agency and NASA. As the first rocket range in Canada, this site was home to extensive suborbital research, including fascinating experiments on the northern lights.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Search for wild polar bears on a full day Tundra Buggy® adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area.

WINNIPEG TOUR: Tour the city of Winnipeg's popular areas, including the historic Exchange District and Forks National Historic Site.
