DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Guests will arrive into Winnipeg and check into their hotel; Welcome reception hosted by a Frontiers North Interpretive Guide; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 2: THE TRAIN VOYAGE BEGINS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Board VIA Rail train early afternoon; Begin first leg of journey to Churchill; Overnight on train.

DAY 3: DAY ON TRAIN (MEALS: B, L, D)

Continue on journey from Winnipeg to Churchill; Overnight on train.

DAY 4: CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Morning arrival into Churchill; Churchill and area tour; Dog Sledding and Interpretive Program; Evening Cultural Presentation from a local Indigenous person; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 5: TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Full day Tundra Buggy® adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 6: EXPLORE CHURCHILL (MEALS: B, L, D)

Parks Canada Visitor Centre; Polar Bears International House; Itsanitsaq Museum; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 7: FINAL TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Full day Tundra Buggy® adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Guests check into their Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 8: DEPART WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure.



Included Activities

CHURCHILL AND AREA TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility, and Inukshuk.

CULTURAL PRESENTATION: An evening presentation from a local Indigenous Churchill resident about the culture, history, wildlife, and/or lifestyle of Churchill.

DOG SLEDDING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding, and enjoy an exhilarating dog sled ride.

ITSANITSAQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre-Dorset, Dorset, Thule, and modern Inuit times.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL HOUSE: Hear from a Polar Bear International representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Search for wild polar bears on a full day Tundra Buggy® adventure in the Churchill Wildlife Management Area.
