DAY 1: WELCOME TO WINNIPEG (MEALS: D)

Guests will arrive into Winnipeg and check into their hotel; Welcome reception hosted by a Frontiers North Interpretive Guide; Overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 2: THE TRAIN VOYAGE BEGINS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Board VIA Rail train early afternoon; Begin first leg of journey to Churchill; Overnight on train.

DAY 3: DAY ON TRAIN (MEALS: B, L, D)

Continue on journey from Winnipeg to Churchill; Overnight on train.

DAY 4: YOUR CHURCHILL ADVENTURE BEGINS (MEALS: B, L, D)

Morning arrival into Churchill; Churchill and area tour; Cultural Presentation from a local Indigenous person; Dan's Diner Culinary Experience and northern lights viewing; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 5: POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL AND THANADELTHUR LOUNGE (MEALS: B, L, D)

Parks Canada Visitor Centre; Itsanitaq Museum; Polar Bears International House; Evening visit to Thanadelthur Lounge for northern lights viewing; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 6: SNOWSHOEING AND FOREST EXCURSION (MEALS: B, L, D)

Interpretive Snowshoe Trek and optional Fat Biking; Tundra Buggy® Adventure; Evening Forest Excursion to view the northern lights; Overnight at Churchill hotel.

DAY 7: LAST DAY IN CHURCHILL (MEALS: B, L, D)

Dog Sledding and Interpretive Program; Evening flight to Winnipeg; Check in and overnight at Winnipeg hotel.

DAY 8: DEPART WINNIPEG (MEALS: NONE)

Guests may depart Winnipeg at their leisure.

CHURCHILL AND AREA TOUR: A guided bus tour of Churchill's most notable sites, including the Polar Bear Holding Facility, and Inukshuk.

CULINARY EXPERIENCE: Travel by Tundra Buggy® across the frozen river to Dan's Diner, an exclusive pop-up restaurant in the wilderness.

CULTURAL PRESENTATION: An evening presentation from a local Indigenous Churchill resident about the culture, history, wildlife, and/or lifestyle of Churchill.

DOG SLEDDING: Learn about Métis culture, the history of dog sledding, and enjoy an exhilarating dog sled ride.

FOREST EXCURSION: Escape the lights of town for aurora borealis-viewing opportunities from an extraordinary locale in the boreal forest.

ITSANITAQ MUSEUM: Tour one of Canada's finest Inuit collections dating from pre-Dorset, Dorset, Thule, and modern Inuit times.

PARKS CANADA VISITOR CENTRE: View incredibly detailed wildlife dioramas and fur trade exhibits that represent the history of Churchill.

POLAR BEARS INTERNATIONAL HOUSE: Hear from a Polar Bear International representative and tour the centre to learn about polar bear research and climate change.

SNOWSHOE TREK: Enjoy the solace of an interpretive snowshoeing adventure through the boreal forest.

THANADELTHUR LOUNGE: Travel by Tundra Buggy® across the river to our warm and secluded lounge for peak aurora-viewing opportunities.

TUNDRA BUGGY® ADVENTURE: Reach remote locales in the wilderness across the frozen Churchill River on board the official Tundra Buggy.
